## 2nd Grade – Summer Reading Program

Summer is a great time when students can ignite their love of reading. Good readers get better when they read, read, and read again. Encourage your student to pick up a picture book, a reader, a magazine, or a chapter book. Invite them to challenge themselves with texts with fewer pictures (chapter books) and read some books just for fun on topics of interest to them. Model good reading for them by sitting and reading a book as well while they are reading. Support them when reading by reading a portion and having them read the next portion. Books can be purchased at a book store (Barnes & Noble, Half Price, online), borrowed from your local library, or even downloaded to an eReader device (Nook, Kindle, iPad). Students do not have to read exclusively from the book list below, but they will need to choose one of the following titles for their summer reading project.

**Summer Project Guidelines:** Project is due on the first Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, and will count as a reading grade.

1. Should be done, as much as possible, by the student
2. Should be creative in nature, in a media that interests the student most - Video/audio recording, PowerPoint presentation, poster board, diorama. May not submit a written book report.
3. Must answer the following questions:
  - What happened in the story (important events)?
  - How is this fractured fairy tale different from the original fairy tale?
  - How are you most like or unlike the main character?
  - What part of the story was your favorite and why?

### **Book List:**

Fractured fairy tales are based on the fairy tale we all have heard and loved but with a delightful difference or twist. Fractured fairy tales lend themselves beautifully to encouraging students to read carefully (decoding, monitoring), to think about what they're reading and compare to other texts (comprehension), and want to read it again (fluency). Students can read as many of these books as they would like, but will need to choose just one to complete their summer reading project.
